Subject: Declaration of Surplus Equipment: SI81 2002 Chevrolet 2500, SH05 1992 Chevrolet 3500, and 2018 CAT Loader

RECCOMENDATION

That the Board declare assets as surplus SI81 2002 Chevrolet 2500, SH05 1992 Chevrolet 3500, MR55 2018 CAT Loader and authorize the disposition of these specific ReGen Monterey assets by selling them for sealed bid solicitation, third-party auction, or scrap market.

BACKGROUND

As in past practice, the request to declare certain ReGen Monterey assets as surplus generally consists of identifying those assets that have reached the end of their useful life cycle service to ReGen operations. The assets defined below have been determined to meet the criteria (see pictures of the assets below). For those vehicles that are governed by Air District or Air Board requirements, the disposition of the vehicle shall be for scrap only.
