# Rate Increase Proposal FY 2024-2025



#### **Budget Timeline:**

- April
  - Discussion of proposed fee changes for purpose of developing budget for FY 2024/25
- May
  - Receive draft budget for FY 2024/25 and provide direction to staff
  - Schedule public hearing for changes to fees
- June
  - Public hearing to consider changes to fees
  - Approval of changes to fees effective July 1, 2024
  - Adopt resolution to approve final budget



#### **Requesting Rate Increase Guidance:**

- Seek Board's guidance for proposed fee changes for the purpose of developing the preliminary budget for FY 2024/2025 for review by the Board next month
- Increase Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) disposal fee from \$74/ton to \$77/ton (~ 4.05%)
- Increase single-stream recyclables (SSR) processing fees to Recology (for San Benito County) from \$37.50/ton and to Republic (for Salinas) from \$36.75/ton to \$40/ton.
- Changes to minimum charge per load and other fees



### Rate Increase Proposal FY 2024-2025 Municipal Solid Waste Fee

#### **Municipal Solid Waste Disposal Fee**

- Increase of \$3/ton from \$74/ton to \$77/ton
- This is approximate increase of 4.05%
- Prior year increase was 5%

#### Cost Factors:

- Ongoing labor negotiations and higher cost of employment
- Rising cost of capital expenditures
- Keeping pace with cost of ongoing regulatory mandates and compliance
- Funding of Capital Infrastructure and Capital Equipment Reserves, established June 2022
- Creation and funding of Closure and Post-Closure Liability Reserves
- Creation and funding of CalPERS Unfunded Pension Liability Reserve




#### Impact by Jurisdiction – Single-Stream Recyclables (SSR) Processing

- Eight (8) member agencies (Monterey excluded) will not see any single-stream recycling price increase—\$40/ton rate will remain.
- City of Monterey does not utilize ReGen Monterey's single-stream processing services thus, no fee is charged for single-stream recyclables processing to the City of Monterey.
